

PENINSULA ARTS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY:

Peninsula Arts Association Scholarship is to be awarded to a graduating senior from the Ocean Beach or Naselle-Grays River School Districts OR a home-schooled graduating student from these districts. Each applicant must be a graduating senior in the current year, have a grade point of 2.5 GPA and developed an interest in art.

Application:

Each student is to submit the following:

- *Transcript of grades
- *References (especially from an art instructor or mentor)
- *Essay by applicant stating reasons they are applying for the art scholarship
- *Current mailing address, telephone number and email address if available.

Interview:

The panel of PAA Scholarship Selection Committee members will interview each applicant. During this interview the applicant shall present their portfolio of art and/or examples of work. The date of the interview to be determined.

Portfolio:

A portfolio of work is required to be shown at the time of the interview. It must include at least one or more actual piece of art (per medium) in its original form. Other portfolio pieces may be images of the applicant's artwork.

Deadline:

All applications are to be completed and received by the Scholarship Selection Committee by Friday, April 29, 2022. Students apply through their school scholarship advisor.

Amount:

Only one scholarship will be awarded to an individual in any given year and PAA reserves the right to withhold any award. The amount of the award shall be determined as described in the By-Laws and has been determined to be \$1,000.00 in 2022. Within one week of interview, the Scholarship Chair will send letters to all applicants with the committee's decisions.
